New Lunchroom Guidelines

Please be aware of the new lunchroom policy (refrigeration and microwave use) policy:

- Students may bring a bag lunch from home.
- ***There is no student access to refrigerators or microwaves. We recommend that the parent prepare lunches that will not need warming up. If a student comes to school with a lunch that needs warming that lunch will be held for the student to take back home and a school lunch will be given to the student instead.***

Accommodating Students with Special Dietary Needs

Parents, if your child has a documented disability that restricts their diet; the school foodservice **must** provide substitutions stated by a licensed physician on a medical statement form. It is the responsibility of the parent to obtain a medical statement form and have it completed by a licensed physician.
